We know change can be challenging and we will support you at every stage of the process, including guidance from our dedicated team of family placement supervisors. Kibble Fostering is proud to provide a service which is seen as sector-leading, with high-quality practice provision, alongside some of the most competitive fees and young person allowances in the country.

Why choose Kibble Fostering?

Pay And Allowances – Competitive fees and allowances

24/7 support - Round-the-clock support for young people and foster carers

Family Placement Supervisors - Experienced social workers, with high levels of practice skills and knowledge, providing direct support and supervision to foster families.

Child And Youth Care Worker - Providing direct practical and emotional support to young people, drawing on a wide range of skills and experience to meet their individual needs and support foster carers.

Training And Qualifications - We'll support you to complete a comprehensive training programme to complement and enhance existing skills.

Carer Team Meetings – Fortnightly meetings for foster carers to discuss young people's needs with the care team, share successful approaches, and access support from other foster carers.

Holiday entitlement - All our carers receive 28 days paid short breaks per year. The exception to this is pro-rata carers.

A smooth and supportive transfer journey

Our team will support a smooth transition through the transfer period, starting with a phone call to discuss your circumstances. We will engage with your current fostering agency or local authority to gather relevant information to complete a comprehensive assessment in a shorter, less intrusive manner than you may previously have experienced. We expect the transfer assessment to take no longer than four months before going to panel.

We shall work closely with you and your current fostering agency to ensure the needs of any children placed with you are fully considered. We will always enter the transfer process with the intention of working together to support and sustain stability of any current placement during this process.
